

"Entrepreneur E2+EB-2 Visa" Incorporating Partnership World Visa with US\$250,000 to US\$1,000,000 Venture Capital Funds



Features:

- A. The Entrepreneur World Visa above has a "Home *Value" of US\$500,000 + for a US Business Resort for Visa Members of the World Export Group LP (WEG) with a separate World Visa Express (WVE) Joint Venture E2+EB-2 Business Visa as herein provided.
- B. The separate WVE Joint Venture provides a 50%-50% E2 Temporary Visa with WVE equity funding for the Visa Member to qualify for a Permanent EB-2 Visa.
- C. Accordingly, the World E2+EB-2 Visa permits you to establish a 50%-50% US profit share business with WVE holding 60% voting share of the Joint Venture.
- D. The Joint Venture commences with JVE assisting WEG Visa Members obtain an E2 Long-Term (4 year+) Temporary-Treaty with WVE's matching investment.
- E. Prior to the World E2 Visa period, the WEG Visa Member's US\$500,000+ ("Unit Funds") Investment must be used to purchase WEG's World Visa 'Units' through WEG's nominated Hong Kong "Trustee".
- F. The Trustee shall be the Custodian of the Unit Funds to ensure the Visa Unit purchases are paid direct to the Partnership's intended U.S. Bank Holding Company "World Holdings Corporation" (WHC-USA).
- G. WHC-USA and its WEP Bank Branches are subject to Section 25A of the USA Federal Reserve Board Act.
Note: WEP Bank Name subject to FRB Approval.
- H. The WEP Bank purpose is to utilise both Copper Cable Asset Funding and World Visa "Unit funds" for the Export / Import Business of the Partnership Joint Ventures with added innovative businesses and ventures for assisting Visa Members qualify for EB-2 National Interest Waiver/s (NIW) after 12 months.
- I. *The NIW shall be further supported During the 12 Month period with the Partnership commencing its "Business Resort/s" with its Copper Cable Assets and World Visa "Unit Funds" to WEP Bank for including EB-2 Visa applicants' Condo / Homes.
- J. The Homes are provided by the Partnership with WEP Bank incorporating a Non-Recourse (Free) 5 year Visa Member Home Loan with mortgage reduced yearly.
- K. Meanwhile Visa Members shall be provided with Reciprocal Use of the "World Experience " Condo and Business Incubator Ship for participating in various training and language skills. This is to ensure the Visa Members qualify for the New Point System being introduced to the USA.

Eligibility:

1. The Partnership must assist in arranging sponsor approval from the USA Border & Customs agency for the Visa Member's E-2 Temporary Visa.
2. The Partnership must provide at least US\$250,000 to US\$1 million for the agreed joint venture with Gross Domestic Product (GDP) benefits to the USA for Visa Members EB-2 Visa
3. Visa Members must agree:
 - 3.1 To apply for the USA E-2 Temporary Visa for qualifying for the Country Treaty Program.
 - 3.2 Hold an initial 50% equity with the Partnership in the Joint Venture Company herein and willing to Manage / Invest or as Retiree, have a JV interest while accepting Dividends from profits.
 - 3.3 Visa Members may be willing to reside in the "World Experience" ship Condo/s with family to refresh English Language Skills and Work Skills with on-board teachers in order to qualify for the "EB-2 NIW Visa in the USA.
4. The Partnership confirms:
 - 4.1 The Partnership must arrange the "Visa Unit" Fund Value Paid (US\$500,000 +) as Non-Recourse Loan for Visa Member's end family Home or Condo; becoming a Free Loan after 5-year term.
 - 4.2 The Partnership has substantial Global Assets available in order to provide the Venture Capital herein through its intended WEP Bank.
 - 4.3 Reciprocal Visa Rights apply to Visa Members during Temporary Visa periods (only) for another Country of Choice available by the Partnership.
 - 4.4 The Partnership may provide Visa Members with an alternate EB-5 Visa or EB-6 Parole Visa upon request during the first two years of Temporary Visa Period.
